8 Ways to Teach to Get Your Point Across



As teachers, we have our go-to methods of teaching, and these methods fit us well like comfortable shoes. Sometimes, our teaching methods are not the best ways for our students to understand what we want them to know.

Because people learn in various ways, we need to be sensitive to utilizing multiple methods; so, everyone learns in manners comfortable for them. Being aware of the different ways people learn and making simple adjustments to our teaching plans creates a better learning environment for the students and makes us better teachers.

Here are 8 identified ways people learn:

- 1. **Linguistic**: People learn through words, debate, stories, and comparisons.
- Logical-mathematical: Learners engage through numbers, logic, cause and effect, and patterns.



4. **Musical**: Students appreciate rhythm, melodies, music, and singing.



- 5. **Bodily-kinesthetic**: These learners enjoy movement, handling objects, and working with their hands.
- 6. **Interpersonal**: People learn through connecting with other people, putting

themselves in someone else's shoes and figuring out someone's intentions.

- 7. **Intrapersonal**: Meditation, soul searching, contemplation, and introspection are important to these learners.
- 8. **Natural**: These learners appreciate nature and outdoor elements.

As teachers, we can learn to incorporate new methods into our teaching plans in order to engage learners in ways comfortable to them. When we stretch ourselves, we provide a better learning environment for those we want to teach.

Let's add a new method the next time we teach to engage people with different learning styles. I challenge you to implement (slowly and over time) all the learning styles to engage all the people in your class.
